THE PROBLEM

The AJ Group was using a standard Wi-Fi system that included a Netgear WNR2000v2 router, other routers, and an access point. Their previous system would not allow users to access the Wi-Fi with a password or a Wi-Fi scanning system. The AJ Group's management team were the only ones to grant access to the Wi-Fi which was not an ideal process.

WHY GRANDSTREAM?

The installer, Grameen Cybernet referred Grandstream to AJ. Due to the Mac filtering system such as whitelist and blacklist, and Grandstream's bandwidth rules as per SSID, it seemed like the perfect solution for this textile company.
